EV Girls Second, Sigourney Sixth at EBF

EDDYVILLE – English Valleys and Sigourney girls travelled to Eddyville this past week for the Eddy Relays. EV scored a runnerup finish in Class B while Sigourney was sixth in a highly competitive Class A. Davis County ran away with the Class A crown with 168 points while Sigourney scored 40.5. Wayne Community dominated Class B with 223. English Valleys used three first, three seconds and scored double in two events to score 89 points.

Sigourney's best finishes were third places in the 800 meters, 3,000 meters and 400 hurdles where they also picked up a sixth place. Carly Good-

win ran the 800 meters in 2 minutes 53.56 seconds with Reanah Utterback taking third in the 3,000 with a time of 13:14.09.

Reagan Clarahan took third and Rain Barthelman was sixth in the 400 hurdles. Clarahan covered the distance in 1:18.41 while Barthelman finished in 1:22.41. High jumpers Erin Dawson and McKinley Chittick placed fourth and fifth respectively. Dawson went over the bar at 4-feet 6-inches and Chittick cleared 4-4. Macy Fisch added a fourth in the shot with a put of 31-6.75.

Clarahan, Mason Clarahan, Hannah Hanselman and Barthelman took fourth in the shuttle hurdle relay in 1:30.58.

In Class B, the field was

chasing Wayne in nearly every event. EV won just one individual event and two relays on their way to the runnerup spot. Kennedy Axmear had a throw of 118-3 for first. Her toss was the longest of the day for either class by nearly five feet.

The 400-relay team of Delaney Hall, Kayli Mohror, Maddie Mikesell and Carly Stanerson finished first in 54.25. Hall, Mohror and Mikesell hooked up with Nevaeh Decker for a win in the 200-meter relay in 1:58.40.

Mikesell and Mohror picked up third and fifth respectively in the 100 meters for one the team's double placing. Mikesell finished in 13.85 while Mohror ran 14.15. The

other double was in the 1,500 with Olivia Heyne in fifth with a time of 6:48.25 followed by Nevaeh Briggs in 7:04.87.

Stanerson was second in the 200 and 400. She clocked a 28.51 in the 200 and 1:04.39 in the 400. Kaeley Axmear nabbed the other second place with a 1:21.12 run in the 400 hurdles.
