Baxter senior Trice Clapper won the shot put at Des Moines Christian on April 24 and then grabbed another win at West Marshall on April 27. Clapper's best throw this year has surpassed 50 feet, which currently ranks seventh in Class 1A.

Clapper's win leads Baxter boys to third at Des Moines Christian

URBANDALE — Trice Clapper grabbed the only win for the Baxter boys' track and field team on April 24, but the Bolts piled up seconds and thirds at the Des Moines Christian High School Coed Invitational.

Baxter scored 119 points in third after registering five runner-up finishes and five third-place tallies.

Host Des Moines Christian won the meet with 213 points and Boone was second with 136.

Pleasantville (110) and Perry (37) finished the top five and Bonduant-Farrar (36), Ankeny Christian Academy (35), Woodbury Academy (29) and Tri-County (8) completed the nine-team field.

Clapper's win came in the shot put. His winning throw covered 48 feet, 2 inches and he also placed sixth in the discus with a toss of 114-10. Jake Travis gave the Bolts double points as he was third in the shot put with a toss of 39-5 1/2.

Logan Rainsbarger and Matt Richardson collected the only two individual runner-up finishes. Rainsbarger was second in the 110-meter high hurdles in 16.39 seconds and Richardson grabbed the silver medal in the 3,200 with a time of 10 minutes, 28.82 seconds.

Rainsbarger was third in the long jump with a leap of 18-5 1/2, Cainan Travis finished third in

the 400 in 54.76 seconds and Treyton Travis ended up fifth in the high jump with a leap of 5-10.

The individual fifth-place finishes came from Alex Dille (12.16) in the 100, Cody Samson (2:12.54) in the 800 and Logan Jones (1:03.81) in the 400 hurdles.

The Bolts were second in the sprint medley, 4x400 and 4x800 relays and third in the 4x100 and distance medley relays.

Cade Robinson, Cainan Travis, Rainsbarger and Carson Scroggins finished the sprint medley relay in 1:41.71, Robinson, Rainsbarger, Cainan Travis and Scroggins completed the 4x400 relay in 3:41.66 and Perrin Sulzle, Samson, Jones and Cody Damman hit the finish line in the 4x800 in 8:54.61.

The 4x100 team featured Robinson, Scroggins, Jake Travis and Cainan Travis and they finished the race in 46.46 seconds.

The distance medley team of Ashton Kerwin, Treyton Travis, Damman and Sulzle ended up with a time of 4:02.28.
