**Southwest Valley Defeat Last Week Makes Playoff Chances Unlikely**

**Dawgs Face Earlham For Final Regular Season Game**

The Bulldogs will host Earlham this Friday night for their last regular season game in a contest where both teams hold 2-5 records.

Both teams have defeated Sidney and both have lost to Mount Ayr, AHSTW, and Southwest Valley.

The only other team both have played was St. Albert and Riverside lost by two points in that contest while Earlham won by 18 points.

The record show that the game will be a close match with the Dawgs having the home field advantage.

Riverside suffered a 49-21 loss on the road to Southwest Valley last week and will be out to wrap up a final season game with a win.

Quarter scoring against Southwest Valley showed as follows:

The Bulldogs were unable to stop the Southwest Valley running game as the Timberwolves had 380 yards rushing compared to Riverside's 86 yards.

Passing, both teams had almost identical yardage at 111 yards for Riverside and 113 yards for the Timberwolves.

Riverside completed 9/25 pass attempts compared to Southwest Valley's 4/5 .

Scoring for the Bulldogs included:

\*Jaxon Gordon ran the ball into the endzone for a two yard touchdown play with only second left in the second quarter.

Davis Bramman added the PAT kick to put the team trailing 21-7 with 0:45 left on the clock.

\* Gordon ran the ball in for a 4 yard touchdown midway through the third quarter for Riverside's second TD of the contest.

The score came at 6:52 showing on the clock. Bramman added another PAT kick with the score standing at 28-14.
